














	carpenter	(der) Schreiner / (die) Schreinerin	A carpenter builds tables, chairs, shelves, etc.	
	caretaker	(der) Hausmeister / (die) Hausmeisterin	A caretaker looks after big buildings.	
	craftsperson	(der) Handwerker / (die) Handwerkerin	A craftsperson works with his hands and builds or repairs things.
